We are glad to report that twelve more people joined AMUAA-GC, and the membership increased from 113 to 125 in last three months.

AMUAA-GC has also recognized the speaker and presented the memorable plaque. Mr. Somnath Ghosh, Counselor General of India Chicago was the chief guest of the event. AMUAA-GC also recognized Dr. Santosh Kumar, Founder, & Executive Director, of Metropolitan Asian Family Services for her Outstanding Community Services and Support of AMUAA-GC. There was also a mini mushaira held at the end of Sir Syed Day Celebrations. Four local poets participated.

The 48th Annual Sir Syed Day Mushaira was held online on Sunday, November 20, 2022. Due to international poet's inability to arrive in the U. S. on time for the Mushaira and Covid situation continuing, the Mushaira was organized online via Zoom under the leadership of Dr. Abdullah of Washington, D. C.

Orphan Girls Hostel project is completed now with the generous support from the AMUAA-GC members. We have provided the complete report with the progress made from March 2022 till September 2022. The project was completed in \$31,000 although the cost estimate provided was \$40,000. The AMUAA-GC EC and Board members thank sponsors and donors for realizing the importance of this project. This residential accommodation will house approximately 40 orphan girls and provide them with a place to stay and get an education in a safe environment.

Sír Syed Day Program, October 22, 2022

AMU Alumni Association of Greater Chicago (AMUAA-GC) organized a program and **Dinner to celebrate the 205th birth anniversary of Sir Syed Ahmad Khan** on Saturday, October 22, 2022, at the BUFFALO GROVE COMMUNITY ARTS CENTER 225 MCHENRY ROAD BUFFALO GROVE, IL 60089, USA. More than 120 people attended the program.

Mr. Ajmal Sufiyan conducted the program as convener of the event. In the welcome note, Ajmal Sufiyan said "Sir Syed has not only opened a college but showed a direction, hope, and vision to the Indians. Sir Syed Day is very close to our hearts and is celebrated all over the world by its alumni and well-wishers in remembrance of Sir Syed Ahmad Khan for his extraordinary contribution towards the educational upliftment of Indian Muslims."

The President of AMUAA-GC, **Dr. Zafeer Ahmad** provided an overview of the organization. AMUAAGC also organized a mini mushaira during its Sir Syed Day Celebrations. Four local poets participated.














Annual Sir Syed Day Mushaira, November 20, 2022

48th Annual Sir Syed Day Mushaira was held on Sunday, November 20, 2022, 10 AM – 1 PM Central Time. Due to international poet's inability to arrive in the U. S. on time for the Mushaira and Covid situation continuing, the Mushaira was organized online via Zoom under the leadership of Dr. Abdullah of Washington, D. C. AMU Alumni Association and a committee consisting of six members representing the participating AMU Alumni Associations of Birmingham, Alabama, Chicago, Illinois, Cincinnati and Cleveland, Ohio, Jacksonville, Florida and Washington, D.C.

The mushaira started about 20-25 minutes late due to technical problems. It was presided over by one of the most senior Aligs in the U. S. and founder of the Los-Angeles based Urdu Markaz International, Nayyar Aapaa. The participating poets included Azhar Inayati and Rajesh Reddy from India, Rafiuddin

Raaz, Rahman Faris and Umar Najmi from Pakistan and Ali Meenai, Nayyara Aapaa and Farah Kamran from the U. S.

The Mushaira lasted for about three hours. Most associations have organized watch parties where members got together to listen to the Mushaira. Thanks to Br. Jawed Aslam who organized the watch party for AMUAAGC members at his house in Villa Park. However, due to cold and rainy weather, very few people showed up at his house. Jawed sahib had an excellent arrangement for watching the Mushaira and provided refreshments and lunch. It is not known how many AMUAAGC members watched the Mushaira. The cost of the Mushaira was \$300.00 for each participating association.

Hopefully the national mushaira will be conducted on-location next year and would attract larger participation from the community.

Educational Project, January 2023.

Report by: Dr. Israrul H. Ansari (Chair, Education Committee)

The president received a new education project from Bhopal, MP. The school was established in 1974 and serves from primary to higher secondary schools. It serves approximately 280 students from poor financial backgrounds (approx. 52% girls and 48% boys). It provides mid-day meals to all kids and has 9 female staffs, 3 male staff, and 4 guest teachers. It has a valid school registration document and a valid FCRA account in state bank of India, New Delhi. The original proposal included school renovation and development of sports facilities. The school was painted nearly 10 years ago, and there has been extensive deterioration in the ceilings and classroom walls. The cracks appeared in many places. The total cost for school renovation and building a playground/sports equipment was proposed. The total cost of the original project was \$35000 in the initial application.

The education committee reviewed the project on November 01, 2022. The committee members liked the project but recommended re-submitting the proposal focusing on a single project. The school management modified the project and re-submitted the project again for school renovation only. The revised project has every minute detail of school renovation. The modified project will cover an area of approximately 5500 sq ft, focusing on school renovation, costing \$20,000. Brother Masood Akhtar, Madison, WI., agreed to sponsor the project and provided 10% of the project's cost. The committee members again reviewed the project on January 02, 2023, and further requested a couple of documents from the school. The request has been sent to the school management, and we are awaiting their responses. The final decision will be based on the availability of documents received and reviewed by education committee members.
