President's Message

As we are getting close to the end of our term, I think we have achieved everything that we have planned - this was only possible by EC and Board members working together and the extraordinary support we received from the general assembly. All these great accomplishments can't be the work of one - it's all of us. You regularly step forward and contributed in so many ways. I am not going to try to highlight all our accomplishments for the year, but there are few that need special mention.

- 1. Bylaws Amendment
- 2. Construction of Orphan Girls Hostel

These two tasks have taken enormous amount of time, but I am glad to report that bylaws amendments are fully implemented, and the orphan girls hostel project is almost complete. The election will be held electronically, according to the new bylaws, as the complete details are provided by the Election Officer. We have allowed everyone to participate in the election if they have renewed their membership after June 30th as we transition to the new bylaws. The General Body (GB) meeting will take place at Century Park on July 23, 2022, at 2:30 pm. The agenda for this meeting and minutes from the last GB meeting were already sent to everyone. A picnic will take place prior to the GB meeting at Century Park on Saturday July 23rd at 12:00 pm.

We have also provided detailed information about the **Sir Syed Global Scholar Award (SSGSA)**. It is a unique approach to support students to gain higher education in the United States or Europe, and **120 students** have benefited from this program. **AMUAA-GC** has made an important contribution towards the success of SSGSA and helped over **20 students**.

We are leaving the organization financially in a very strong position. The revenue has increased over \$101,000 over the last year. We started with \$14,186.25 in our bank account in July 2021 and ended with the balance of \$72,423.11 at the end of June 26, 2022., even though we had a major expense of \$31,000 for the Orphan Girls Education project. We have been very transparent and diligent in utilizing the funds towards value-added initiatives for AMUAA-GC.

In closing, I thank you for giving me the opportunity to serve as your president. We started our term with a commitment of transparency and engagement, and I hope we met your expectations. I would like to thank the EC and Board for their high level of commitment to AMUAA-GC.

Sir Syed global Scholar Award (SSGSA)

At SSGSA we believe that Education is critical for the success of every human being. It transforms the young mind to develop self-esteem and the strength to face any challenge in life.

At the inception we started as Sir Syed Excellence in Science Award (SSESA) that was focused on the Science and Engineering students but later we expanded to all branches of education and changed the name to Sir Syed Global Scholar Award or SSGSA. Our goal is to nurture leadership from those who received the SSGSA award and who are motivated and enthusiastic to support students and above all believe in taking the torch forward without self-interest fulfilling the Sir Syed vision.

Unique approach to support students to gain higher education in the United States or Europe

One of the first hurdle we encountered is the funds as application for admission in US is expensive especially going through taking standardized tests such as GRE, TOEFL etc. along with the application fees that could cost over \$1000 for each student.

So, we realized that when the resources are limited bottom-up approach makes take time so supporting students with mentoring and paying the application fees may help more students that led to the success of 120 students in getting admitted in a short time.

SSGSA Model - We support each scholar in achieving their full potential

Let's get into how SSGSA works. It has 4 parts *Mentoring, Application Support, Financial Assistance and Support Network.*


Mentoring is the key element where students have 1-on-1 help available so he or she can understand the system of what it takes to apply to foreign institutions. We want to ensure that students are strongly committed as it is a relatively long process and could take a year before you start your graduate studies at the reputed foreign university.

Application support involves providing guidance on the preparation of standardized tests and helping to finalize the application material.

SSGSA pays only for GRE, TOEFL and application fees for up to 5 universities. This itself costs over \$1000. **AMUAA Chicago** made an important contribution towards the success of SSGSA and helped over 20 students by offering financial aid during the application stage.

Support Network is also important once the student joins the university. We arrange to make connections in the university town, so the settling is not cumbersome. At the end each student becomes a part of SSGSA family while in the program or after the program they help each other in job placements etc.

We would like to end with the following remarks "We contribute to student's success by enabling them to gain higher education but behind the scene, it is a giant success for their families, the community and the nation as a whole."




Fighting and Reducing The Risk of Cancer

There is no magic pill, but consider these guidelines to prevent cancer:

- Eat plenty of fruits and vegetables. Base your diet on fruits, vegetables and other foods from plant sources such as whole grains and beans.
- Weight Control- Avoid obesity. Eat lighter and leaner by choosing fewer high-calorie foods, including refined sugars and fat from animal sources.
