## President's Message

As we are getting close to the end of this fiscal year, we have achieved so many things - this was only possible by EC and Board members working together and the extraordinary support we received from all of you. Here are some of our accomplishments for the year.

- 1. Recognition of Dr. Santosh Kumar and Mr. Shahid Ahmed for their Enormous Contributions
- 2. Initiation of Boys Residence for Hira Public School Project
- 3. Approval of Hira Public School Girls Hostel and Warden Residence Project

Aligarh Muslim University Alumni Association of greater Chicago (AMUAA-GC) organized a Sir Syed Iftar/Dinner event on March 25, 2023. The total fundraising target was \$65,000 to complete two projects from Hira Public School. We collected approximately \$43,000 at the end of this program, however, some people continued to donate. We have an opportunity to raise at least \$23,000.00 more to complete these projects with the help of two major donors and your support.

I am glad to report that EC/Board agreed to increase the funding from \$2,000.00 to \$3,000.00 for **Sir Syed Global Scholar Award (SSGSA).** All of us agree that this is an excellent program for AMUAA-GC to support.

The General Body (GB) meeting will take place online through Zoom on June 18, 2023. A picnic is scheduled at Century Park on September 9, 2023. Sir Syed Day Program is scheduled on October 21, 2023, at Falak Banquet, Villa Park.

We started with \$72, 508.63 in our bank account on July 15, 2022, and ended with the balance of \$105, 159.37 at the end of May 9, 2023, even though we had an expense of \$10,000 for Hira Public School Education project.

In closing, I thank you for giving me the opportunity to serve as your president. We started our term with a commitment to transparency and engagement, and I hope we met your expectations. I would like to thank the EC and Board for their high level of commitment to AMUAA-GC.

# Sir Syed Day Iftar and Dinner, March 25, 2023

Aligarh Muslim University Alumni Association of greater Chicago (AMUAA-GC) organized a Sir Syed Iftar/Dinner event on March 25, 2023. This is the key event of AMUAA-GC to raise funds for Girls Education Projects. Dr. Haris Jamil was the Convener of the event. The program started after Iftar and dinner with the recitation of Holy Quran by Mariam Sheikh.

Dr. Zafeer Ahmad, President of AMUAA-GC gave an update about the organization and emphasized how AMUAA-GC is helping in many ways to uplift the socially, economically, and educationally deprived population of India. Education Projects update was given by Dr. Zafeer Ahmad who presented the Orphan Girls Hostel project that was completed in September 2022 with a cost of \$31,000.00. Two new projects presented were by Hira Public school at Answer, Ambedkar Nagar, UP. The first project was Residence

Area for Boys. The cost of this project was \$10,000 and construction was started. The second project included Girls Hostel and Warden Residence. The cost of this project presented was \$51,000.00. The total fundraising target was \$65,000 to complete these projects. We collected approximately \$43,000 at the end of this program, however, some people continued to donate.

The keynote Speaker, Imam M. Musa Azam-Ibrahimi was introduced by Dr. Ahmadullah Siddiqi. Imam Musa emphasized the importance of educating girls in society and how education helps in the overall development of a community and the nation. The program ended with the vote of thanks from Dr. Ahmadullah Siddiqi, chairman of Board of Directors.

# Opportunity to Raise Additional Funds

Two AMUAAGC life members provided an excellent opportunity to meet the funding requirement for Hira Public School Girls Education Project. For every \$1,000.00 donated by the members, Dr. Abdul Wase will match it up to \$10,000.00 and Dr. Munavvar Izhar will donate \$1,000.00 for every \$3,000.00 donated by the members. These offers are valid till July 22, 2023.

# Educational Project, May 2023

### Hira Public School – First Project

The organization received a new education project from Hira Public School, Ambedkar Nagar, UP. As we



all know, the Hira Public was initially funded by AMUAA-GC well-wishers in 1988. Since then, the school has made good progress and expanded to hold classes up to 10+2 grade as per the CBSE course curriculum. As of now, the school has 1000 boy and 800 girl students and 90+ teaching and non-teaching staff. The school requested to build a big hall (~20 X 14 ft), a kitchen, and a bathroom to

provide residential accommodation to approximately 16 male students for an estimated cost of \$10,000.00. The project was sponsored by Mr. Wakil Ansari, Chicago, IL and the education committee unanimously approved this project. The proposed site of construction, construction map, and a few contraction images are listed below.







As evident from the images above, the project is almost getting to its completion. The AMUAA-GC EC/Board members thank the sponsor and donors.

This residential accommodation will house approximately 16 boys who have difficulty in commuting to school and make the best of this opportunity to prepare for their competitive exams. The AMUAA-GC also thanks the entire Hira Public School administration for their commitment to completing the project in time.

Hira Public School - Second Project




After the completion of the above project, another request came from the same Hira Public School to fund the construction of a girl's hostel and Warden Residence for a total cost of about 50k USD. The EC and Board along with the education committee, decided to split the project into two phases and fund the first phase of construction of the Girls' hostel by the end of this year 2023. After having a satisfactory response, the AMUAA-GC will fund the second phase of construction of Warden Residence probably in Early 2024.


Following are the proposed phases of construction and associated funding amounts:

Phase I - Girls Hostel: Estimate 2123131.00 INR (~25600 USD)

Phase II - Warden Residence Estimate: 2110535.00 INR (~25000 USD)


Dr. Masood Akhtar, Madison, WI, and AMUAA-GC president, Dr. Zafeer Ahmad agreed to jointly sponsor the first phase of the project (Masood Akhtar donated \$2,000.00 & Zafeer Ahmad donated \$560.00). The educational committee further reviewed the first phase of the project and approved it for funding. After getting approval from members of the general body, AMUAA-GC plans to transfer the funds soon. The proposed map, and construction site is listed below:





# Additional approval of \$11,000 for Hira public school

- ♣ Approval of an additional \$11,000 fund required from the General Assembly after meeting the maximum limit of \$25,000 for Hira Public School projects.
- We had sent a ballot to all 108 eligible voters at AMUAA-GC that includes life members and annual members.
- Ballots were sent on their personal email ids and mobile numbers. Ballot has unique Ids which cannot be transferred to anyone else, and it is for the only members who are eligible to vote.
- The ballot was 100% delivered to all voters in their email. However, some 7 members' mobile numbers were incorrect and therefore were not delivered as shown in the screenshot below.
- The election was conducted through a secret ballot that means even administrators cannot see who voted whom or what was selected while voting.
- → 74 members out of 108 general assembly members (i.e., 69% of total votes) participated in this approval process where 73 members approved this additional fund of \$11,000 to Hira Public School. Only 1 member rejected this, which is 1.35% of the total voters.
- ♣ Therefore, based on the above result it is concluded that an additional fund of \$11,000 is granted to Hira Public School which has been approved by AMUAA-GC's general assembly with 98.65% votes in favor.



We thank everyone from the general assembly who took part in this approval process and strengthened this democratic process.
